WHERE TO USE

QUANTOM[®] EPR 3001 is a general purpose epoxy resin and can be used in the following applications:

- Installing FRP fabrics on concrete substrates in wet lay-up and dry lay-up strengthening systems
- Installing FRP fabrics on wood, Steel, Aluminium and other metalic substrates
- Implantation of anchor bolts
- Anchoring Dowels and rebars
- Bondind precast concrete segments together
- Crack sealing and nipple installation for epoxy resin injections
- Bonding load bearing objects on steel, concrete, masonry, wood, stone, FCB, etc.

HOW TO USE

Surface preparation

substrate must be sound and free of loose particles. Remove dust, laitance, oil, grease, curing compounds, impregnations, waxes, foreign particles, disintegrated materials, and other bond inhibiting materials from the surface. Surface can be prepared by blasting methods, grinding or chipping. Substrate must be dry with no standing water.

APPLICATION

Apply QUANTOM[®] EPR 3001 in wet lay-up and dry lay-up strengthening systems according to the QUANTOM[®] wrap fabrics data sheets.

Mixing

Mix each component separately. Add component "B" to Component "A" and mix them thoroughly using a low speed drill (max. 300 rpm) and suitable paddle for at least 3 minutes or until all striations have disappeared and a uniform mixture is obtained. For partial mixing, proportion 1 part of component "B" to 3 parts of component "A" by weight or volume into a clean pail. Mix only that quantity which can be used within its pot life.

Priming

Dry and moist surfaces require no primer or bonding agent.

Material consumption

Approximately 0.8 to 1.2 Kg/M2 for installation of fabrics in normal thickness.

Do not apply QUANTOM[®] EPR 3001 at temperatures bellow 5 °C. Do not thin QUANTOM[®] EPR 3001 by solvent. Solvent will prevent proper cure. Do not load the installed objects before curing time.

Storage / Shelf life

Store out of direct sunlight, and protected from extreme heat and cold. The shelf life for originally unopened package is 24 months from date of production.

Delivery

QUANTOM[®] EPR 3001 is available in 4.00 kg and 10.00 kg pails.

Safety precautions

Product may cause skin irritation. Wear gloves and goggles. In contact with eyes or mucous membrane, flush immediately with plenty or warm water and seek medical attention without delay.
